**FOR THE UNITED KINGDOM USE ONLY**

**Requirements**

- Please note stallions are not permitted.
- The horse needs to be vaccinated with the first 2 flu vaccines prior to arrival.
- The horse needs to be at least two years old, physically sound and mature to be started.
- The owner must have at least third party liability cover for their horse.

**Location:** Dudgeley Farm, Lower Wood, All Stretton, Shropshire SY6 6LE

**Acceptance:** At the end of the horse's training the owner will have the opportunity of attending a two day course with David at Dudgeley Farm where you will be provided with instruction to set yourself up for the future.

**Fee:** £1,080.00 for 4 weeks training, grass livery and 2 day clinic.
